One of the highlights of my career took place in 2011 when I earned a Community Safety Award from my employer for helping to save a 10-year-old from drowning.

While at an end-of-school pool party at a private local residence, the attendees performed a count among the swimmers to make sure that everyone was present and accounted for. When one of the homeowners realized that 1 boy was not included in the count, he immediately looked in the pool and discovered — to his horror — that this child had sunk to the bottom of the deep end of the pool. This homeowner was able to lift the boy out of the pool and onto dry land.

As the only attendee certified to perform CPR, I immediately went to work on this boy who had stopped breathing. After 3 successful rounds (that seemingly took forever!), I was able to locate a pulse. Performing CPR was an action that ultimately revived this child.

Even though this incident took place over 10 years ago, I still uphold a pronounced mandate to deliver professional and top-quality patient care in emergency, high-stress, and rapidly changing environments while always addressing my patients' health needs, personal concerns, and safety.

If your facility is looking for someone with that kind of fierce work ethic, then I would welcome the prospect of further discussions in an interview.
